

I.N.G.A. newsletter is an annually distributed electronic newsletter with its main focus on different aspects of the superfamily Gelechioidea. The goals of the newsletter are:

Guidelines for submissions

The newsletter publishes non-reviewed articles, news, announcements, a list of current publications, reviews, loan and exchange requests and biographical presentations of people interested in Gelechioidea. Subscription and all contributions are free of charge. Submission should be made electronically as .doc, .docx or .rtf files with all figures and tables submitted as .jpg, .gif or .tiff files set at the printed size and resolution of ca. 100-200 dpi. Please include figure legends and photo credit information at the end of a text file. Please build tables in your word processor so that the cells can be easily re-sized to fit the page during the layout process. The submitted texts should be in English and sent to the editors by October 31st and include the author's contact information (institution and department (if applicable), e-mail address). The newsletter follows the bibliographic style of Zootaxa. Submissions may be edited, but the information content will not be modified.
